

ORDINANCE NO. MC-1005

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10-58 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMEWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF PERMITTED CLASS 10 BEER AND WINE ONLY LIQUOR LICENSES FROM ZERO TO ONE

WHEREAS, Paresh & Gayatri Inc. has requested a Class 10 beer and wine only liquor license for their proposed location at 18747 Dixie; and,

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commissioner and Board deem it appropriate to issue a Class 10 liquor license to Paresh & Gayatri Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois that

SECTION ONE-AMENDMENT TO CODE

Section 10-58 of the Homewood Municipal Code is hereby amended by deletion of the following language, TO-WIT:

“(10) Class 10 licenses shall be limited to zero”

And by substitution therefore of the following language, TO-WIT:

“(10) Class 10 licenses shall be limited to one”


SECTION TWO-EFFECTIVE DATE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10-58 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMEWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, TO RESTORE THE NUMBER OF CLASS 4B LIQUOR LICENSES UPON SURRENDER OF THE CURRENT LIQUOR LICENSE

WHEREAS, Jie Shun Inc. d/b/a Asian Harbor holds a Class 4B liquor license for their location at 1930 Ridge Road; and,

WHEREAS, Asian Harbor has recently changed owners and Fang's Fusion Inc. has applied for a liquor license for 1930 Ridge Road; and,

WHEREAS, the liquor commissioner deems it appropriate to issue a class 4B liquor license to Fang's Fusion Inc. for the location at 1930 Ridge Road;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois that

SECTION ONE-AMENDMENT TO CODE

Section 10-58 of the Homewood Municipal Code is hereby amended by restoration of the following language upon surrender of the current liquor license, TO-WIT:


“(4B) Class 4B licenses shall be limited to two”
