

ORDINANCE NO. MC - 1015

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 42
OF THE HOMEWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING CHARGES
FOR PARAMEDIC TRANSPORTATION

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois that:

SECTION ONE-AMENDMENTS TO MUNICIPAL CODE:

Section 42-62 of the Homewood Municipal Code is amended by deletion of the entire section and by substitution of the following:

Sec. 42-62 Charge for paramedic transportation. Every person transported by village paramedics in a village vehicle from a location within the village to a hospital, office, or medical facility shall pay to the village for such transportation and services the following fees:

Payment shall be due upon receipt. Charges may be waived or reduced if the Village Manager or his/her designee determines that the patient lacks sufficient financial resources to pay the billed amount.

SECTION TWO-EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall be in effect after its passage, approval, and publication in accordance with the law.
