

ORDINANCE NO. MC- 1030

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10-58 OF THE HOMEWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE INCREASING THE NUMBER OF CLASS 4B 75/25 RESTAURANT WITH BAR NO VIDEO GAMING LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, Section 4-1 of the Liquor Control Act of 1934 (235 ILCS 5/4-1) authorizes a municipality to determine the number, kind, and classification of licenses for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor and local license fees to be paid for each license category.

WHEREAS, Maple Tree Inn, Inc. has requested a Class 4B 75/25 Restaurant with Bar No Video Gaming liquor license for their proposed location at 18849 Dixie; and,

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commissioner supports issuing the requested license, provided the proposed licensee submits a completed application and acceptable background checks for all liquor managers and the licensee are completed.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois that

SECTION ONE - AMENDMENT TO CODE

Section 10-58 of the Homewood Municipal Code is amended by deletion of the following language, TO-WIT:

“(4B) Class 4B licenses shall be limited to five”

And by substitution therefore of the following language, TO-WIT:

“(4B) Class 4B licenses shall be limited to six”

SECTION TWO - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication in accordance with law, provided the proposed licensee submits a completed application and acceptable background checks for all liquor managers and the licensee are completed. If all of the aforementioned conditions are not completed within ninety (90) days after approval of this ordinance, this ordinance shall be revoked.
