

VILLAGE OF HOMEWOOD
BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING
PUBLIC HEARING
TUESDAY—APRIL 9, 2019
VILLAGE HALL BOARD ROOM

CALL TO ORDER: Village President Hofeld called the public hearing on the 2019-2020 budget to order at 7:30 p.m. There were eight members of the public present and one press representative.

ROLL CALL: Clerk Marilyn Thomas called the roll. Those present were Village President Richard Hofeld, Trustee Barbara Dawkins, Trustee Lisa Purcell, Trustee Karen Washington, Trustee Lauren Roman, Trustee Jay Heiferman and Trustee Larry Burnson.

Finance Director Dennis Bubenik outlined the major points of the budget. He gave a full report on the budget at the March 26, 2019 meeting of the Board of Trustees.

Director Bubenik said the surplus amount given at that March meeting was incorrect. The village is starting the 2019 budget year on May 1 with a surplus of \$538,000.

He thanked the businesses in town for their continued support. He said approximately 70 percent of the budget comes from sales taxes. Director Bubenik also thanked Village Manager Jim Marino for smooth day-to-day operations of the Village; President Hofeld and Trustees for their time reviewing the budget and appropriations; and Assistant Finance Director Amy Zukowski for her diligence in assisting with the preparation of all the paperwork that goes into preparing the budget.

President Hofeld asked the public for comments. None were offered.

President Hofeld asked the Trustees for comments. Each thanked Director Bubenik for his outstanding efforts in preparing the budget.

President Hofeld adjourned the meeting at 7:35 p.m.
