



## Family Fire Safety Video Challenge

Each day during the week of October 5 thru October 9 families are asked to perform and video themselves and their families performing the fire safety task of the day.

### Day 1 - Survey your home and make a plan

As a family, walk around your home checking for possible exits from each room. Be sure to decide on two-ways out of every room. Also make note of where the smoke detectors are on each floor.

Once you have gathered your information, as a family, [draw a floor plan of your home](#) and mark two exits from every room on your floor plan, include the locations of your smoke detectors.

Be sure that if a child is to use the second exit from a room that they know EXACTLY WHAT they are to do and HOW they are to do it. If your child is too young or if you have a disabled person living in your home, how will they escape? Who will be responsible for getting those in need of help out of the building? Now is the time to make these plans and include them in your home escape map.
