



## Family Fire Safety Video Challenge

### Day 2 Pick an outside

### meeting place

Decide on an outdoor meeting place for the family. Make this someplace away from the home, like a neighbor's front porch or in front of their garage door. Mark the meeting place on your home escape plan. Make sure everyone knows that in a fire they should leave the building quickly and go directly to the pre-arranged meeting place. No one should EVER go back into the building for any reason!

An outdoor meeting place should be near something easy to remember and away from the house. DO NOT choose a fire hydrant since during a real fire the hydrant may be at the center of the action.

Something important to remember about an assigned meeting place is that it will help you know that everyone is out safely. When the fire department arrives, they will ask if everyone is out. If you don't know or aren't sure, firefighters may waste precious time in fighting the fire and have to risk going into a building to look for someone who is safely outside.
